Under this agreement for 2016 Mundubbera State School will receive

\$146,135*

This funding will be used to

- 40% students attain an A or B in Maths, 35% English, 45% in Science
- 91% of students attain a C or better in Maths at age specific benchmarks
- 82% of students attain a C or better in English at age specific benchmarks
- 90% of students attain a C or better in Science at age specific benchmarks
- 97% of students attain the NMS in Writing, Numeracy and Reading
- 20% students achieve U2B in Writing and Numeracy
- 95% Yr 3 achieve aspirational sight work targets, 95% Yr 2, 70% Yr 1, 20% of Preps
- 95% Yr 3 achieve Numeracy milestones, 95% Yr 2, 95% Yr 1, 85% of Preps
- 65% of Preps achieve mastery within the SEAPART 5 testing protocols
- 100% of inaugural vocational education students achieve selected qualification

Our initiatives include

- Liaising with Dr Harry Kanasa (Griffith University) to plan, demonstrate, observe and share numeracy best practice with in the school
- Building capacity of the Community of Practice group - Numeracy, in the Central Queensland Region. Specifically developing the proficiency strand of mathematical fluency
- Liaising with Dr Gary MacLennan and Ian Mackie to re-culture using the Nudge Theory to improve mathematical teaching and Learning
- Developing an agreed school plan for mathematical teaching and learning
- Developing shared numeracy resource kits across the school
- Purchasing Speech Language Pathologist time to improve early year's oral language development
- Developing teacher capability, physical resourcing and planning documents for school STEM program.
- Building capacity, resourcing and structures that support increased physical activity in Prep - year 3

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| Capacity building through professional development, internal and external to the school | \$53,000 |
| Resourcing; physical numeracy kits; writing/reading, STEM, gross and fine motor control structures | \$23,135 |
| Purchase teacher aide time targeting literacy groups from Prep – 3, 4-6 and 7-10 | \$33,000 |
| Purchase teacher time to develop planning, analysing and enacting whole school plans in writing and numeracy | \$ 7,000 |
| Targeted funding to support SLP into the school for extra 1.5 days a week | \$23,000 |
| Teacher time to develop and monitor Individual Curriculum Plans | \$ 7,000 |
